

GLOBAL SLEEPOVER AROUND THE GARDEN

MATERIALS:

PAPER, CRAYONS, GLOBAL SLEEPOVER WORLD MAP, SCISSORS, GLUE AND/OR IF YOU HAVE THE SPACE, A REAL GARDEN.

1. Choose 3-4 countries.

Be imaginative and pick countries that we don't hear much about!

2. Research and discover which plants, vegetables, and flowers grow in that country. What spices, herbs or ingredients are used most often?

3. Choose one plant from each country.

4. Download and print the world map.

5. Draw the flag of the country and a picture of the plant. Then cut out the flag and plant and glue it to the world map!

6. If you have a garden space, obtain the seeds for the plants you selected.

7. Clear a garden plot and divide it into four sections. Assign one section per country. Plant the seeds for each respective country.

8. Laminate the flag and drawing of the plant that the child created. Glue the lamination to a wooden stick and use that as a plant marker. Voila! You have a Global Sleepover Around the World Garden! Don't forget to send in pictures or videos to: info@globalsleepover.com
